Mixing Desks

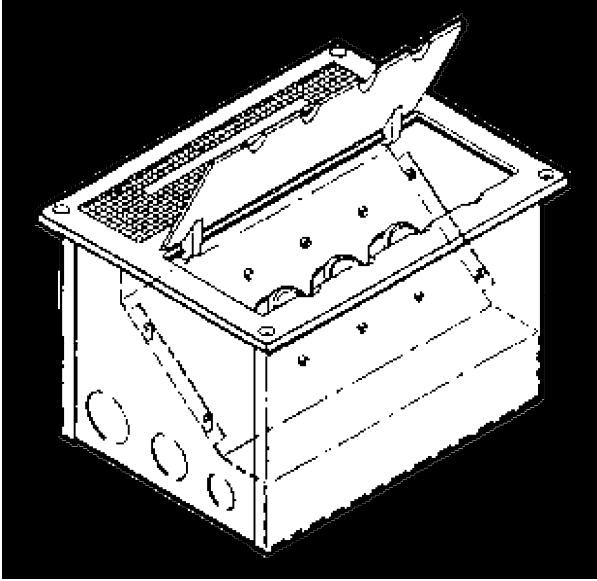

Stand Mount Monitor

This new approach to personal monitors enables a single microphone stand to hold both the monitor speaker and a microphone. This frees up space on the platform and minimizes clutter. Because the monitor is closer to the user, less amplifier power is required and overall monitor volumes are lower. This translates into greater overall system clarity. These speakers have many optional attachments that allow them to hang from a ceiling, mount to a wall, or be placed on a tabletop.

Floor pockets

Floor pockets provide protection and convenient access to audio, video, and AC connectors. Constructed of durable 11-gauge steel, these floor pockets flush mount into the floor of a chancel or platform. Each unit incorporates a black carpet trim ring with a beveled edge. Cable-clearance slots in the door allow it to close over cables when in use.

Slim Pulpit Microphones

These pencil thin condenser microphones provide minimal visual obstruction. Designed for quality sound reinforcement, they provide a uniform polar pattern with a narrow 90°-acceptance angle. This helps minimize feedback, especially if your church has an overhead speaker cluster. They can plug into a standard XLR-type connector, or direct mount to a microphone stand using the supplied thread-mount adapter. Available interchangeable elements permit angle of acceptance from 90° to 360°. The small-diameter, double gooseneck design allows flexible positioning.
